

UTSA Summer Research Program

A Summer 2009 Research Program for University of Texas at Brownsville students interested in future study toward a master's or doctorate degree at *The University of Texas at San Antonio*.

- Full-time assignment with a UTSA faculty mentor
- \$3000 stipend for a 10 week summer session
- The student will either be assigned to a UTSA dorm or be provided an equivalent housing allowance
- GRE or GMAT prep course (paid contingent on taking the exam by the end of the 10-week period)
- A one-time \$5000 recruiting scholarship if the summer research intern applies, is admitted, and begins a UTSA graduate program.
- Assignment is contingent on finding a match with a UTSA faculty mentor.

Stipend Requirements:

- Upper Division undergraduate students or first year master's students
- Applicant must be a serious potential candidate for a UTSA graduate program. See <http://www.utsa.edu/graduate/> for information regarding UTSA graduate programs.
